Dear Applicant:

The following is information about obtaining or renewing the St. Clair County Extended Transportation permit. The Extended Transportation permit fees and requirements are as follows:

**Permit fee is \$ 100.00 First Permit/ \$25.00 Each Additional Permit Annually per Power Unit.**

(The permit will be issued for the Power Unit; however each piece of equipment above legal axle loading not exceeding 25% must have a separate application filled out so the Road Commission is able to accommodate your route accordingly.)

- Permits will not be issued for oversize or overweight vehicles or loads which can be readily dismantled, reduced, or otherwise rearranged to come within the legal limits.
- Permits will be issued for oversize or overweight vehicles or loads which do not exceed 12 ½ feet in width, 14 feet in height, 85 feet in length; and not to exceed more than 25% of normal axle loading, with no wheel to exceed 700 pounds per inch of tire width.
- Route approval will be necessary for overweight loads only. Attached is a form most permit holders have used in the past. Please complete this form and fax or email it for route approval prior to moving. The form will be returned to the applicant once approved. We will make every effort to approve or change the route as expeditiously as possible. This form is to be completed for overweight loads only.
- The Extended Transportation permit is not valid for building moves (i.e., mobile homes, portable offices, garages, shed, etc.)

**Insurance Requirements prior to issuance:**

General Liability

Unless otherwise specifically required by special provisions in the proposal, the minimum limits of property damage and bodily injury liability covering each contract shall be:

Bodily Injury and	\$1,000,000 Each Occurrence
Property Damage	\$1,000,000 Aggregate

Automobile Liability

Unless otherwise specifically required by special provisions in the proposal, the minimum limits of property damage and bodily injury liability covering each contract shall be:

Bodily Injury and Property Damage	\$1,000,000 per Accident
Michigan No-Fault	- Personal Injury Protection
	Property Protection Indemnity

**\$10,000 Continuous Surety Bond**
