
SUBJECT: Transfer of Primary Road Funds to Local Roads

ADOPTED: December 9, 2010


Per Act No. 143 of Public Acts 2010, should a road commission have surplus funds for primary road maintenance in its budget, those funds may be transferred as follows:

1. Not to exceed 30% annually, primary road funds may be transferred to the local road system.
2. An additional amount, not to exceed 20% annually, may be used for emergencies or if the road commission determines an additional 20% may be expended on local roads.

It shall be the policy of this Board that should there be surplus primary road funds available for transfer for use on the local road system and should the Board approve the transfer of the allowable funds, these funds shall flow through approved Road Commission programs that require at least 50% matching funds from the townships, or be used for project(s) as determined by the Board at its discretion.
