SUBJECT: Letter of Understanding bwtween the St. Clair County Drain Commission
and the St. Clair County Road Commission

Pursuant to our conversation at the Road Commission meeting of February 12, 1980, the St. Clair County Drain Office agrees to guarantee that any road crossings disturbed by contractors employed by this office will be repaired to the satisfaction of the Road Commission.

For a period of two years from the time the crossing is made, this office further guarantees to reimburse the Road Commission for any expense that it incurs in making repairs that the contractor fails to do after he has been notified.

This agreement is in conjunction with a motion made by the Road Commission February 12, 1980, exempting contractors employed by the Drain Office and Road Commission requirements concerning cash deposits and surety bonds for road crossings. Drain Office contractors will be required to adhere to all other current Road Commission requirements on open cut crossings.




