SUBJECT: Special Assessments for Road or Street Improvements

AMENDED: April 1, 1997

PURPOSE: To provide a policy for the procedure to improve by special assessment any road or street in the county outside the corporate limits of any city or village which is designated as a public highway.

LEGAL CITATION: Act 188, Public Acts of 1954, as amended
"Township Public Improvements Act"

Policy: Special assessments of property benefited by improvements to roads and streets under the jurisdiction of the Board of County Road Commissioners will be assessed and collected by the appropriate Township.


An agreement for engineering and construction of such improvements will be entered into with the Road Commission by the Township.

All engineering and construction, including the awarding of contracts therefore, in connection with such improvements will be performed by or under the supervision of and in accordance with the specifications of the Board of County Road Commissioners. The cost of such engineering, construction and supervision will be paid to the Road Commission by the Township from the funds of the special assessment district.
