
SUBJECT: Removal of Hazardous Waste Material From Public Road
Rights-of Way

AMENDED: June 5, 2001


It shall be the policy of the St. Clair County Road Commission that none of its employees or equipment be used to remove hazardous waste material from public road rights-of-way.

The St. Clair County Road Commission will provide assistance with traffic control including the erection of road closure barricades and signs and the establishment of detours if needed.

In the event of a small quantity fluid spill such as motor oil, fuel oil, gasoline, engine coolant or other known substance, employees shall apply Oil Dry or sand to affected area to correct the problem without delay.
