
SUBJECT: Mailbox Replacement Policy

ADOPTED: March 22, 2005


It shall be the policy of the St. Clair County Road Commission to repair or replace mailboxes and/or mailbox supports damaged as a result of physical contact with road commission vehicles during road maintenance activities.

Following notification, inspection and verification by St. Clair County Road Commission supervisors that the mailbox and/or support were damaged by contact with road commission equipment, and that the damaged mailbox and/or support appeared to have been installed properly, St. Clair County Road Commission will attempt repairs to the damaged mailbox and/or support.

In the event it is determined replacement is necessary, a one-time payment of up to \$45 per snow season will be authorized per homeowner; the reinstallation will be up to the homeowner. However, a lower payment may be authorized if it is determined that the value of the actual damage is less.
