
SUBJECT: Engineering Plan Requirements for Construction within  
County Road Commission Right-of-Way


AMENDED: June 2, 2009

For any project that would be constructed in the Road Commission right-of-way, prior to the design or engineering of the project, written approval from the Road Commission must be received on the initial concept. An agreement with the Road Commission must be signed before approval of any contract.

All plans submitted to the St. Clair County Road Commission for work in the Road Commission right-of-way shall include all necessary grades, elevations, cross-sections, profiles, details, specifications and materials to construct and restore the right-of-way to current Road Commission standards. The plan must contain provisions for the proposed removal of any obstructions or encroachments located within the public right-of-way including, but not limited to: trees, fences, headwalls, boulders, and landscaping. This work includes, but is not limited to, water main, sanitary sewer, storm sewer, public utility projects, and non-motorized trails and sidewalks.

No construction work shall be started in the county road right-of-way until the plans have been approved and the necessary permits issued by the St. Clair County Road Commission.
