SUBJECT: Establishment of Speed Limits on County Roads per MCL 257.627


LEGAL CITATION: MCL 257.627

PURPOSE:


To establish procedures for establishing speed limits on county roads under the provisions of MCL 257.627 and for the rescission of previously established speed limits, if necessary.

PROCEDURE:

1. The director of engineering, county traffic engineer or his/her representative shall determine what county roads or sections of county roads meet the criteria included in MCL 257.627 for the establishment or revision of a regulatory speed limit and shall submit a written request for approval of same to the managing director on the form "AUTHORIZATION FOR SPEED LIMIT".
2. Upon approval by the managing director, the "AUTHORIZATION FOR SPEED LIMIT" shall be submitted to the Board of County Road Commissioners for approval.
3. If approved by the Board, copies of the signed "AUTHORIZATION FOR SPEED LIMIT" shall be sent to the township board(s) of the township(s) wherein the affected roads are located and to the Sheriff.
 - a. If the affected road(s) are subject to a previously issued Traffic Control Order (TCO) from the Michigan State Police, then the portion of the "AUTHORIZATION FOR SPEED LIMIT" to rescind the TCO shall be signed by the Board and sent to the township board(s) wherein the affected road(s) are located.
 - b. Upon receipt of township approval to rescind the previously issued TCO, the "AUTHORIZATION FOR SPEED LIMIT" shall be sent to the Michigan State Police for its approval to rescind the TCO.
4. The necessary signs shall be properly posted in accordance with the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
