OF THE COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR**

**SUBJECT: Public Utility Vehicles Permits During Spring Weight Restrictions**


**ADOPTED: April 15, 2008**


**Legal Citation: Act No. 41, Public Acts of 2002 amending M.C.L. 257.722, as amended by P.A. No. 658, 2006.**

**Pursuant to the above legal citation, the Board of St. Clair County Road Commissioners will require and issue permits for Public Utility Vehicles during spring weight restrictions in the following manner:**

- 1. Permit must be carried in the vehicle.**
- 2. Speed limit not to exceed 35 m.p.h.**
- 3. Normal road classification loadings shall be allowed.**
- 4. Time and date of desired movement must be specified and approved by the St. Clair County Road Commission Special Services Department personnel.**
- 5. Permit may be suspended if the weather or road conditions warrant.**
- 6. Permit application fee shall be \$75.00 for annual move.**
- 7. A bond shall be provided in the amount of \$10,000.00**
- 8. The permittee shall indemnify and hold harmless the St. Clair County Road Commission, commissioners and employees from any or all suits, claims and damages of any kind arising out of, or by reason of the permit.**
- 9. Any of the following actions shall immediately void the permit:**
  - a. Non-compliance with the conditions, restrictions or provisions of the permit;**
  - b. A change or erasure on the permit.**

10. Staff shall be charged with the responsibility to provide a permit form setting forth the herein incorporated provisions. Pursuant to M.C.L. 257.722 (5) a minimum of 48 hours advance notice or application must be provided in order that the above 1 through 9 provisions may apply.
11. Should the move be of an emergency nature, the public utility company must provide notification to St. Clair County Road Commission within twenty-four hours of the event.
