- Reported on the challenge to MDOT's decision to cease payments for acceptance of state roads into county systems. A letter from MDOT to Senator Carl Levin had been found stating payments for road takeovers are perpetual.
- Discussed a possible change in union representation.
- Reviewed an issue with mud from a farming operation obstructing a road.
- Noted the only contact to use impending ARPA funds for roads has come from County Commissioner Dave Rushing.

Commissioner Ward had the following:

- Inquired about the culvert replacement on Norman Road, and the crane set in place.
 Director Hazelton reported the crane is for MDOT's project on Norman Road, and that
 the Road Commission's culvert replacement is on hold until the MDOT project is
 completed.
- Noted the issues Mr. Luca had raised earlier. Chairman LaLonde directed that those in violation should be sent notices.

Commissioner Lauwers asked when the bridge project at Goodells Park would be complete.
