2025 NORTHERN PAVING PROGRAM BID:

On a motion by Commissioner Lauwers seconded by Commissioner Ward the 2025 Northern Paving Program Bid be awarded to Hutch Paving in the amount of \$2,053,289.37. Commissioner Ward inquired about the bid. Director Hazelton replied that the Northern Paving Program is bid as a bundle, Hutch Paving is a company based out of Warren, Michigan, and that references were verified. Motion Carried 3-0.
