### **CAPITAL OUTLAY PURCHASE:**

Commissioner Lauwers inquired if the excavator that was being purchased was used. Director Hazelton replied that we are buying the excavator and bucket from the County who is paying off the machine. We are paying to outfit the machine and that is being done by Michigan Cat. On a motion by Commissioner Lauwers seconded by Commissioner Ward the purchase of a 320 Excavator and attachments from Michigan Cat in the amount of \$123,855.54 be approved. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Lauwers inquired if this MDOT engineering reimbursement was done on an annual basis. Director Hazelton replied that it was completed on an annual basis. On a motion by Commissioner Ward seconded by Commissioner Lauwers Resolution No. 25-16 authorizing the certification and request for reimbursement as specified by Act 239 for the employment of a professional engineer be approved.
