GENERAL

All work under this contract shall conform to the Michigan Department of Transportation's current Standard Specifications for Construction.

PROTECTION AND RESTORATION OF PROPERTY

The contractor shall restore, at their own expense, any public or private property damaged or injured in consequence of any act or omission on their part or on the part of their employees or agents to a condition similar and equal to that existing before such damage or injury was done. If the contractor neglects to repair or make restorations the Managing Director may, after 48 hours notice to the contractor, proceed to make such repairs or restorations and will deduct the cost thereof from any monies that are or may become due to the contractor.

CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR WORK

Payment for Idle Equipment and Labor

The contractor shall, prior to execution of the contract, file with the Road Commission a certificate that they carry Worker's Compensation Insurance which the Contractor will keep in force for the duration of the contract.

General Liability

QUANTITIES AND LOCATIONS

Maps and quantity sheets showing the locations and the amount of aggregate to be placed at each location will be provided before the work is to start. Also, a work schedule will be provided to coordinate work between the contractor and the SCCRC. Locations, quantities and schedules will be updated and revised as necessary.

HAUL ROUTES

It shall be the contractor's responsibility to obtain approval from the SCCRC of any haul route that will be used on a continuous daily basis.

Upon award of the contract and prior to starting the project an agreement of route selections shall be made by general consensus of the parties at a pre-construction meeting.

DELIVERING AND SPREADING
